

Come Fish Alabama Fishing Trip Checklist

- Batteries Check If Charged Properly
- Gas Check that tanks are full
- Mixing Oil If applicable make sure tank is full
- Fuel Stabilizer Added to fuel
- Trim and Trim Switches Make sure trim is working properly
- Trailer Tires Check for proper tire pressure
- Trailer Lights Check that all trailer lights are working
- Trailer Bearings Check and Grease Trailer Bearings
- Trailer Hitch Check hitch to make sure it is latched and snug
- Boat Tie Downs Check tie downs for fraying or looseness
- Check Boat Seats and Poles Make sure seats set upright and are secure
- Check Power Poles Check power poles for proper operation
- Check Power to Sonar/GPS Ensure Depth Finder Sonar GPS is powering up
- Drain Plugs Ensure drain plugs work properly and are secure
- Aerators Make sure aerators and live wells are operational
- Trolling Motor Make sure trolling motor is operating properly
- Lights Check Navigational lights and console lights
- Fire Extinguisher Ensure Fire Extinguisher is charged and not expired
- Horn Ensure horn works
- ECOS Lanyard Make sure ECOS Lanyard is in place and operational
- Life Jackets Check Life Jackets for Rips and Tears
- First Aid Kit Ensure First Aid Kit has not expired and is sealed
- Fishing License Ensure Your License is Current
- Rain Suit Check for rips tears and mold
- Fishing Gloves Same as above Check for rips and tears
- Polarized Sunglasses Make sure you have these and they are cleaned
- Hat Pack this also
- Cast Net Check to make sure there is no dryness and tares
- Catfish Jugs or Noodles Make sure there strung with hooks and weights
- Live Bait Ensure your live bait is alive and secured
- Minnow Bucket Store and ensure you have the lid
- Rod and Reels Got to have these rigged and ready
- Tackle Boxes Pack these
- Fishing Line
- Hooks
- Weights
- Plastic Baits
- Jigs
- Spinner Baits
- Crankbaits

- Sunscreen
- Pain Reliever
- Cooler Ice
- Drinks
- Snacks
- Extra Socks and Shoes
- Hand Towel
- Spot Light
